THEMES, ISSUES AND EXPECTATIONS OF ART AND SOCIAL WORKERS IN ASIA


Conducting from 25/08/2021 to 11/10/2021

(Each respondent could select ONE option to indicate their top priority concern)














Arts sector concerns:


(Each respondent could select ONE option to indicate their top priority concern)
